EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed Palo Alto Networks has issued a cybersecurity advisory addressing multiple Chromium vulnerabilities incorporated into its Prisma Access Browser product.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Palo Alto Networks has issued a cybersecurity advisory addressing multiple Chromium vulnerabilities incorporated into its Prisma Access Browser product. This update includes patches for 16 CVEs ranging from use-after-free, heap buffer overflows, to improper input validation — all of which pose high risks to confidentiality, integrity, and availability.

While there is no evidence of active exploitation, these vulnerabilities can be leveraged via network-based attacks and require active user interaction, but no privileges or special configurations. Palo Alto Networks urges customers to upgrade affected versions immediately.
