## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed Google recently released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in the Chrome browser.

## TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Google released a security update for Chrome browser to address multiple vulnerabilities. These vulnerabilities could potentially allow attackers to remotely execute malicious code on a victim's machine, leading to data theft, system compromise, or other malicious activities.

### Vulnerabilities Details:

- **CVE-2024-4058** (Critical Severity): Type Confusion in ANGLE
- **CVE-2024-4331** (High Severity): Use after free in Picture In Picture.
- **CVE-2024-4368** (High Severity): Use after free in Dawn
