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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed a code execution vulnerability has been identified in VMware Fusion, a virtualization software for macOS.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

A code execution vulnerability (**CVE-2024-38811**) has been identified in VMware Fusion, a virtualization software for macOS. This vulnerability could allow a malicious actor with standard user privileges to execute code in the context of the Fusion application.

- **CVE ID: CVE-2024-38811**- VMware Fusion code-execution vulnerability
- CVSSv3 Range: 8.8
- A malicious actor with standard user privileges may exploit this vulnerability to execute code in the context of the Fusion application.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends to update VMware Fusion to the fixed version at the earliest.
