Critical Vulnerability in TI WooCommerce Wishlist plugin

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed a critical vulnerability in the TI WooCommerce Wishlist plugin that could allow attackers to inject malicious code into the affected site, potentially leading to data exfiltration, website defacement, or complete takeover.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Vulnerability Details:

- **CVE-2024-43917**
- **CVSS Score: 9.3 (Critical)**
- A critical security vulnerability has been identified in the TI WooCommerce Wishlist plugin, affecting thousands of WordPress websites. This vulnerability allows unauthenticated attackers to execute arbitrary SQL queries, potentially leading to complete site takeover.
- Successful exploitation of this vulnerability could allow attackers to:
 - Access and manipulate sensitive data stored in the WordPress database
 - Take over the website, potentially leading to defacement, data breaches, or other malicious activities
 - Compromise the website's security and reputation

Affected Versions:

- All versions of TI WooCommerce Wishlist up to and including 2.8.2

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- **Deactivate and Delete the Plugin:** The most immediate and effective measure is to deactivate and delete the TI WooCommerce Wishlist plugin from the WordPress installation.
- **Monitor for Updates:** Keep an eye on the TI WooCommerce Wishlist plugin's official repository or the WordPress Plugin Directory for a patched version. As soon as a patch becomes available, update the plugin immediately.
