## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Apple has released security updates for its products. These updates include important bug fixes and address multiple vulnerabilities in iPhones and iPads.

## TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Apple has released security updates for its various products. These updates include important bug fixes and address the following vulnerabilities in iPhones and iPads.

### Vulnerability Details:

- **CVE-2024-44207:** Audio messages in Messages may be able to capture a few seconds of audio before the microphone indicator is activated. This issue was addressed with improved checks.
  - Unauthorized audio recording could potentially compromise user privacy.
- **CVE-2024-44204:** A user's saved passwords may be read aloud by VoiceOver. A logic issue was addressed with improved validation.
  - Unauthorized disclosure of saved passwords could lead to identity theft or unauthorized access to accounts.
