EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Google has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in the Chrome browser.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Google has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in the Google Chrome browser. These vulnerabilities could potentially be exploited by malicious attackers to compromise a user's system.

High-Severity Vulnerabilities:

- **CVE-2024-9602:** Type Confusion in V8. This vulnerability could lead to arbitrary code execution if a user is tricked into visiting a malicious website.
- **CVE-2024-9603:** Type Confusion in V8. This vulnerability could also lead to arbitrary code execution if a user is tricked into visiting a malicious website.

- Stable Channel Update for Desktop
 - Chrome 129.0.6668.100/.101 for Windows, Mac

 - Chrome 128.0.6613.186 for Windows and Mac
- Chrome 130 (130.0.6723.40) for Android
- Chrome Stable 130 (130.0.6723.37) for iOS

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends to update Google Chrome to the latest version.
