EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Google has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in the Chrome browser.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Google has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in the Google Chrome browser.

Vulnerabilities Details:

- **High** CVE-2024-10229: Inappropriate implementation in Extensions in Google Chrome prior to 130.0.6723.69 allowed a remote attacker to bypass site isolation via a crafted Chrome Extension
- **High** CVE-2024-10230: Type Confusion in V8 in Google Chrome prior to 130.0.6723.69 allowed a remote attacker to potentially exploit heap corruption via a crafted HTML page.
- **High** CVE-2024-10231: Type Confusion in V8 in Google Chrome prior to 130.0.6723.69 allowed a remote attacker to potentially exploit heap corruption via a crafted HTML page.

Fixed Versions:

- Stable Channel Update for Desktop
 - 130.0.6723.69/.70 for Windows, Mac and 130.0.6723.69 for Linux
- The Extended Stable channel has been updated to 130.0.6723.70 for Windows and Mac
- Chrome 130 (130.0.6723.73) for Android

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends to update Google Chrome to the latest version.
