EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Google has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in the Chrome browser.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Google has released security updates for the Chrome browser to address multiple vulnerabilities. These vulnerabilities could potentially be exploited by attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause denial-of-service conditions on affected systems.

High-Severity Vulnerabilities:

- CVE-2024-10826: Use after free in Family Experiences.
- CVE-2024-10827: Use after free in Serial.

Fixed Versions:

- The Stable channel update:
 - Chrome 130.0.6723.116/.117 for Windows, Mac
 - Chrome 130.0.6723.116 for Linux
- The Extended Stable channel update:
 - Chrome 130.0.6723.117 for Windows and Mac
- Chrome 130 (130.0.6723.102) for Android

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends to update Google Chrome to the latest version.
