EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Progress Software Corporation has issued a critical security bulletin for its WhatsUp Gold network monitoring software, to address multiple vulnerabilities.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Progress Software Corporation has issued a critical security bulletin for its WhatsUp Gold network monitoring software, revealing three high-severity vulnerabilities.

Vulnerabilities Details:

1. CVE-2024-12108 (CVSS 9.6, **CRITICAL**)
Description: Allows attackers to gain complete control of the WhatsUp Gold server via the public API.
Impact: Potential for full system compromise and unauthorized access to sensitive data.
2. CVE-2024-12106 (CVSS 9.4, **CRITICAL**)
Description: Enables unauthenticated attackers to configure LDAP settings.
Impact: Possible unauthorized access and potential for data breaches.
3. CVE-2024-12105 (CVSS 6.5, **Medium**)
Description: Allows authenticated users to extract sensitive information through specially crafted HTTP requests.
Impact: Potential disclosure of sensitive system information.

Affected versions:

- WhatsUp Gold versions prior to 24.0.2.

Fixed Versions:

- WhatsUp Gold versions 24.0.2

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends to upgrade the affected versions to the fixed versions at the earliest.
