Security Updates – Google Chrome

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Google has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in the Chrome browser.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Google has released a security updates for the Chrome browser to address security vulnerabilities. Users are strongly advised to update their Chrome browser to the latest version to protect themselves against potential exploitation.

This update includes **two (2)** security fixes. One highlighted fix is a **high-severity vulnerability**.

Vulnerability Details:

- [CVE-2025-3066] High: Use after free in Site Isolation.
- This vulnerability could allow a remote attacker to potentially exploit memory corruption via a crafted HTML page.
- Successful exploitation of these vulnerabilities could potentially lead to:
 - Arbitrary code execution
 - Memory corruption
 - Other unspecified security breaches

Fixed Versions:

- Stable Channel Update:
 - o Chrome 135.0.7049.84/.85 for Windows, Mac
 - o Chrome 135.0.7049.84 for Linux
- Extended Stable Updates
 - o Chrome134.0.6998.196 for Windows and Mac
- Chrome 135 (135.0.7049.79) for Android
- Chrome Stable 135 (135.0.7049.83) for iOS

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends to update Google Chrome to the latest version.
