**Security Updates - Microsoft**

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Microsoft has released security updates to patch multiple vulnerabilities in its products.

## TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Microsoft's May 2025 security updates address over 70 vulnerabilities, including five actively exploited zero-days and two publicly disclosed zero-days. Several critical vulnerabilities affecting Azure services and Microsoft Power Apps were also patched.

### Actively Exploited Zero-Day Vulnerabilities

- **CVE-2025-30400:** Microsoft DWM Core Library – Use-after-free flaw enabling local privilege escalation to SYSTEM.
- **CVE-2025-32701:** Windows Common Log File System Driver – Use-after-free flaw allowing local privilege escalation to SYSTEM.
- **CVE-2025-32706:** Windows Common Log File System Driver – Improper input validation enabling local privilege escalation to SYSTEM.
- **CVE-2025-32709:** Windows Ancillary Function Driver for WinSock – Use-after-free flaw allowing local privilege escalation to SYSTEM.
- **CVE-2025-30397:** Microsoft Scripting Engine – Type confusion vulnerability enabling remote code execution via malicious links in Edge or Internet Explorer.

### Publicly Disclosed Zero-Day Vulnerabilities

- **CVE-2025-26685:** Microsoft Defender for Identity – Improper authentication allowing unauthenticated LAN-based account spoofing.
- **CVE-2025-32702:** Visual Studio – Command injection vulnerability enabling unauthenticated local code execution.

### Critical Vulnerabilities in Azure and Power Apps

- Azure DevOps (CVE-2025-29813) – CVSS 10.0
- Azure Automation (CVE-2025-29827) – CVSS 9.9
- Azure Storage Resource Provider (CVE-2025-29972) – CVSS 9.9
- Azure (CVE-2025-30387) – CVSS 9.8
- Microsoft Power Apps (CVE-2025-47733) – CVSS 9.1

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends applying the security updates recently released by Microsoft.
