EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Google has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in the Chrome browser.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Google has released urgent security updates for the Chrome browser to address multiple high-severity vulnerabilities. Notably, CVE-2025-4664 is being actively exploited in the wild. Immediate action is required to protect against potential attacks.

Vulnerabilities Details:

1. CVE-2025-4664 – Insufficient Policy Enforcement in Loader (High)
 - Insufficient policy enforcement in Chrome’s Loader component may allow attackers to bypass security restrictions, potentially leading to data leakage or account compromise.
2. CVE-2025-4609 – Incorrect Handle Provided in Mojo (High)
 - Incorrect handle management in the Mojo IPC layer could allow privilege escalation or other malicious activity.

- Stable Channel Update for Desktop:
 - Chrome 136.0.7103.113/.114 for Windows, Mac
 - Chrome 136.0.7103.113 for Linux
- Chrome 136 (136.0.7103.125) for Android

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends to update Google Chrome to the latest version.
