Security Updates - Chrome OS

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Google has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in Chrome OS.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Google has released a Long Term Support (LTS) Channel Update for ChromeOS to address multiple security vulnerabilities, including a high-severity type confusion issue in the V8 engine. These vulnerabilities could potentially allow attackers to execute arbitrary code, escalate privileges, or cause system instability.

Vulnerability Details:

- **CVE-2025-13224** Type Confusion in V8 (Severity: High): A flaw in the V8 JavaScript engine could allow an attacker to execute arbitrary code or crash the system via crafted web content or malicious applications.
