EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that ASUS has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in its Asus Router.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Security researchers have identified multiple vulnerabilities affecting ASUS router firmware across the 3.0.0.4_386, 3.0.0.4_388, and 3.0.0.6_102 series. ASUS has released updated firmware (October 2025 release) that mitigates the disclosed vulnerabilities. Users of End-of-Life (EOL) router models, which will not receive new firmware updates, must apply configuration-based mitigations to reduce exposure. These vulnerabilities range from Medium to Critical severity, with potential impacts including unauthorized access, high-impact availability compromise, and remote exploitation depending on the specific CVE.ASUS strongly urges all users to update their router firmware immediately to the latest available version.
