EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed multiple vulnerabilities in Trend Micro Apex One that could potentially allow remote code execution or local privilege escalation under certain conditions.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Vulnerability Details

- **Console Directory Traversal Remote Code Execution**
 - **CVE:** CVE-2025-71210, CVE-2025-71211
 - **CVSS:** 9.8 (Critical)
 - A directory traversal vulnerability in the Apex One management console could allow a remote attacker to upload and execute arbitrary code on affected systems. Successful exploitation may lead to full system compromise.
- **Scan Engine Link Following Privilege Escalation**
 - **CVE:** CVE-2025-71212
 - **CVSS:** 7.8(High)
 - A link following vulnerability in the scan engine could allow a local attacker to escalate privileges on affected installations.
- **Origin Validation Error Privilege Escalation**
 - **CVE:** CVE-2025-71213
 - **CVSS:** 7.8(High)
 - An origin validation error could allow a local attacker to escalate privileges by bypassing security validation mechanisms.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends updating the affected versions to the fixed or latest versions released by Trend Micro.
