Security Updates – Google Chrome

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that Google has released security updates to address multiple vulnerabilities in the Chrome browser including an actively exploited vulnerability in the wild.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Google Chrome has released a Stable Channel update addressing 21 security vulnerabilities, including multiple high-severity memory corruption issues such as use-after-free, heap buffer overflow, and integer overflow.

Notably, **CVE-2026-5281** (Use-after-free in Dawn) is actively exploited in the wild, significantly increasing the risk to unpatched systems. Successful exploitation could allow attackers to achieve remote code execution (RCE), sandbox escape, or system compromise via malicious web content.

Actively exploited vulnerability:

- **CVE-2026-5281 (Dawn)**: Impacts Chrome's WebGPU/Dawn component, potentially enabling drive-by exploitation via crafted web pages.

- CVE-2026-5280 – Use-after-free in WebCodecs
- CVE-2026-5282 – Out-of-bounds read in WebCodecs
- CVE-2026-5283 – Inappropriate implementation in ANGLE
- CVE-2026-5284 – Use-after-free in Dawn
- CVE-2026-5285 – Use-after-free in WebGL
- CVE-2026-5286 – Use-after-free in Dawn
- CVE-2026-5287 – Use-after-free in PDF
- CVE-2026-5288 – Use-after-free in WebView
- CVE-2026-5289 – Use-after-free in Navigation
- CVE-2026-5290 – Use-after-free in Compositing

Medium Severity Vulnerabilities

- CVE-2026-5291 – Inappropriate implementation in WebGL
- CVE-2026-5292 – Out-of-bounds read in WebCodecs

 - Chrome 146.0.7680.177 (Linux)

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The UAE Cyber Security Council recommends to update Google Chrome to the latest version.
