**Critical cPanel Authentication Vulnerability**

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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed that a critical authentication vulnerability has been identified in cPanel that may allow unauthorized access to hosting control panels.

## TECHNICAL DETAILS:

A critical authentication vulnerability has been identified in cPanel that may allow unauthorized access to hosting control panels. The issue impacts multiple supported versions and affects core authentication mechanisms used in both cPanel and WHM interfaces.

Although full technical details have not been publicly disclosed, the vulnerability is considered high risk due to its potential to enable account compromise and administrative access. Hosting providers such as Namecheap have already implemented temporary mitigations while deploying official patches. Immediate patching and mitigation are strongly recommended.

### Technical Details

- **Affected Software:** cPanel & WHM
- **Vulnerability Type:** Authentication Bypass / Unauthorized Access
- **Severity:** Critical (Exact CVSS not disclosed)
- **Exploit Status:** Not publicly confirmed, but treated as high risk due to nature of flaw

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

### Apply Updates Immediately:

- Upgrade to the latest patched version of cPanel.
