**Multiple Vulnerabilities in VMware Cloud Foundation Operations**

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed multiple stored cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities in VMware Cloud Foundation Operations and related products. These flaws could allow an authenticated attacker with privileges to create policies, views, or text widgets to inject malicious scripts and perform unauthorized administrative actions within affected environments.

## TECHNICAL DETAILS:

### Vulnerability Details

- **CVE-2026-41722, CVE-2026-41723, CVE-2026-41724**
- **Severity:** High | **CVSS v3.1:** 8.0
- VMware Cloud Foundation Operations contains multiple stored cross-site scripting vulnerabilities. An attacker with privileges to create policies, views, or text widgets may exploit these flaws to inject and execute malicious scripts, potentially resulting in unauthorized administrative actions within the application.
- Successful exploitation may enable authenticated attackers to execute malicious scripts within the application context, potentially leading to unauthorized administrative actions, session compromise, and manipulation of application content.
