Critical Remote Code Execution Vulnerability in Adobe Campaign Classic

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The UAE Cyber Security Council has observed Adobe has released a security update for Adobe Campaign Classic to address a critical vulnerability tracked as CVE-2026-48286.

TECHNICAL DETAILS:

Adobe has released a Priority 1 security update for Adobe Campaign Classic to address a critical vulnerability tracked as CVE-2026-48286. The flaw is caused by incorrect authorization (CWE-863) and can allow an unauthenticated attacker to execute arbitrary code remotely, potentially resulting in complete compromise of affected systems.

The vulnerability carries the maximum CVSS v3.1 score of 10.0 (Critical). Adobe has stated that it is not aware of any active exploitation in the wild at the time of publication. The advisory applies only to on-premises Adobe Campaign Classic deployments, including hybrid deployments with on-premises components. Adobe-hosted environments have already been remediated.

Immediate Actions:

- Upgrade Adobe Campaign Classic to fixed version or later.
