
In light of the current circumstances the FSRA is writing to all firms under our supervision to confirm that we remain fully operational and contactable, albeit some employees may be working remotely. Supervisory activities continue on a business-as-usual basis, and we expect firms to continue their usual engagement with their assigned supervisory contacts.

Firms are reminded of their regulatory obligation to notify the FSRA promptly of any material developments that may affect their operations, financial position, systems and controls, client servicing capabilities or ability to meet regulatory obligations. This includes any contingency measures activated, changes to operational arrangements (including remote working) or other adjustments either implemented or under consideration.

Firms should assess any potential impact of the current circumstances on their operations and ensure that appropriate governance and oversight continues. Should any material issues arise, or are reasonably expected to arise, your supervisory contact should be notified without delay and thereafter.
