REGISTRATION AUTHORITY CIRCULAR NO. (2) OF 2017: CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION ("CCTV") CAMERA REQUIREMENTS

The purpose of this circular is to notify you of new requirements with respect to the operation of CCTV cameras in your establishment. Pursuant to Article 11(6) of Law No.4 of 2013, the Registration Authority requires you to adhere to the following requirements with immediate effect:

- 1. **Report Defective Cameras**: if a CCTV camera becomes defective, apart from arranging for it to be repaired as soon as possible, you must notify the Registration Authority in writing not later than three (3) business days after the camera is identified as defective.
- 2. **Viewing CCTV Recordings**: under <u>no circumstances</u> may you or any customer view any CCTV recording at your establishment for any purpose.

Should a situation occur that requires the need to view the CCTV footage, you and/or your customer (depending on the situation) should file a Police report, and only the Police may view the recording.

Where this occurs, you should also notify the Registration Authority.
